

the leader's call

As a leader of your student group, you will form a team of university students and professional associates who will serve together to help give a significant boost to a long-term missions project.

Students will gain a sense of how God can use them and their academic or professional career on a short-term mission experience serving the growth of the Kingdom of God. Everyone serves and learns while gaining a vision for the nations.

Student teams will gather for a one-week Orientation Seminar and a day of Cultural Awareness training. Afterward, teams will serve Ministry Projects in the host country. At the conclusion, teams will take a few days of Debriefing to reflect on how God is glorified as we answer His call.

These internships offer a unique exposure to missions and an invaluable testing ground experience challenging students to new applications of their academic field. These teams are NOT highly structured; so Christians with flexibility and initiative are best served through this program.

Your students will see how the role of intercession will integrate into their studies as they observe, serve, research, and write about their experience. Students will produce a report for the field project host and for academic credit.

The result of this intensive time will be a team of new visionary leaders on campus.



the internships

Student teams of 3 to five participants will serve and learn in the following project areas:

- Agriculture
- Water Resource Engineering
- Business & Computers
- Education & Teaching English
- Journalism & Photojournalism
- Social Work
- Health Care
- Environmental Studies
- Video & Web Development

Your team should have a minimum of 3 and no more than 5 participants. It is not a requirement that every applicant is studying in the particular field of expertise, however each participant must be willing to fulfill the project requirements.

group application

the next step

1. Register

Go online to register and indicate the internship project(s) your student organization desires to serve. Get syllabus, current information, application, and leader contact information by visiting our web site at <http://www.haystack.org>.

2. Dates

The typical 8-week Internships are scheduled from the beginning of the 3rd week of June to the end of the first week of August.

3. Tuition

Students in USA: \$1700 USD

Other Countries: ask about fee scale for your country

Professional Associates: (min. 3 weeks)
\$250 per week

Tuition will cover all room and board, all ground transportation needed for the team, and other ministry-related expenses. Airfare is **NOT included**. Airfare varies depending on fare fluctuations and ministry locations.

4. Deposit

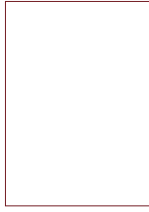
A deposit of 20% is required upon acceptance and no later than April 15th to secure placement. The balance is due before arrival at Orientation.

5. Credit

Credit is granted through the University of the Nations or may be transferred when applied for in advance. This seven- to eight-week program grants six to seven semester-equivalent credits; credits will vary according to full teaching-learning weeks.

Applying the Word of God

These summer internships are designed for student groups to integrate various courses of study in university with ministry as a reflection of the character of God and a Biblical revelation of calling. The goal of our study of the scriptures is to gain revelation of the call of God to traditional and non-traditional fields of service. Students will have opportunity to develop leadership skills and learn how various courses of study in university are part of God's vision for the nations and the needs of the world.
